“The importance of flexibility in a changing world”

Dr. Stager is an eco-physiologist exploring how songbirds respond to environmental change. Research in her lab is mainly aimed at characterizing how organismal responses are built across levels of biological organization, what fitness benefits they confer, and how they are shaped by evolutionary processes. She combines field studies and laboratory experiments, and employs tools from physiology and ecology with those from population genetics and functional genomics to more deeply understand the evolution of physiological traits.
